Sustainable Design

Edinburgh

Join us for a five-day excursion to Edinburgh, running from Monday to Friday. We will dedicate two days to Edinburgh's harbour sites, focusing on the sites for the sustainable urban block development. These days will include time for designing, measuring, and photographing the areas for future project work.

On Wednesday, we'll visit the Edinburgh College of Art at the University of Edinburgh, where Prof. John Brennan, Chair of Sustainable Architecture, will introduce us to the city. Following his recommendations, we'll tour two housing projects and the Royal Botanic Garden Edinburgh to learn about sustainable design and ecosystems.

We also plan to visit Lauriston Agroecology Farm, a collaborative agriculture initiative in northern Edinburgh, to draw inspiration for integrating food production into urban spaces (subject to confirmation).

In addition, we'll walk around Edinburgh to explore iconic sites such as the English Gardens on Calton Hill and discover pocket parks for outdoor design ideas.

The total cost for this week-long architectural journey is estimated at max 600 CHF. Don't miss the chance to deepen your understanding of sustainable design in this wonderful city!
