



Workshop: Sommerakademie Hochrhein 2025

The final grade is calculated according to the weighting of the following components: final submission (60%), active participation (20%) and final presentation (20%). At the «Sommerakademie Hochrhein 2025», sustainable solutions for landscapes, urban development and mobility are designed in interdisciplinary studios. Planning cultures are exchanged and learnt from each other. Students and young professionals work in professionally guided discussions and with experts on site. Platforms for exchange, networking and knowledge enrichment are offered. A week of living and working on the Hochrhein with excursions, public discussions and lectures.

The Rhine forms the landscape and connects the two Swiss cantons of Aargau, Baselland and the German state of Baden-Württemberg. A historically evolved region whose cross-border experience is to be re-established. Sustainable concepts for suburban and peri-urban areas, biodiverse agriculture and climate-adapted living environments are to be developed as models for other European regions.
