Excursion

Sustainable Design

London

From 29 September to 3 October, the Advanced Studio in Sustainable Design will embark on an excursion to London. Over five days, you will explore the city's architectural and urban landscapes, with a special focus on the Newham district and the Royal Docks.

For two days, you will walk extensively, observing, sketching, and photographing the area. You will choose a site for your semester project and have the opportunity to visit it individually toward the end of the week.

The program also includes a visit to Kew Gardens, where architecture and nature come together, offering inspiration for thinking about how to make our cities greener and even edible.

In parallel, we continue our collaboration with Professor C.J. Lim from the Bartlett School of Architecture. You will visit the Bartlett, take part in a workshop with his students, and gain insight into London's approach to sustainable urban development.

The estimated cost of the week is CHF 600, depending on your choice of travel and common accommodation.
