For men: Smart Business or Business Casual is among the most fluid and varied of dress codes. Generally speaking, ties are not worn with business casual. Most codes require that a collared shirt be worn. Dress pants or cotton twills such as chinos (khakis) are acceptable, but jeans are not.
