Public Transport

Reaching Airport Zürich

The closes airport to Liechtenstein is Zurich International Airport (ZRH).

- Distance 115 km
- Mode of transportation: train or car

There are two routes from the airport to the university:

- 1.) Via Sargans
Take a train to Sargans, then **Bus 11** to the university
- 2.) Via Buch SG
Take a train to Buch SG, then **Bus 11 or 12** to the university



Reaching Memmingen Airport

Memmingen Airport (FMM) is a smaller regional airport in southern Germany.

- Distance: 120 km
- Transportation: Train or bus

- 1.) Take the train from Memmingen train station to Feldkirch (AT)
- 2.) At the train station in Feldkirch take **Bus 11** to the university

FlixBus – Vaduz Stop

The nearest FlixBus stop is in Vaduz, the capital of Liechtenstein.

Traveling around Switzerland and Austria

The most convenient and efficient way to explore both Switzerland and Austria is by train.

In Austria: Use the ÖBB app for up-to-date train schedules and tickets

In Switzerland: The SBB app is your go-to tool for navigating the Swiss rail system.

Both Swiss and Austrian railway companies offer travel cards that provide discounted fares for trains and other modes of transport:

Getting Around Liechtenstein and Nearby Regions:

The most convenient way to travel within Liechtenstein and its neighboring cities in Austria and Switzerland is by bus. For easy planning, download the **LIEmobil** app, which provides real-time bus schedules and route information.

Ticket Options:

- **Single Tickets:** Available for purchase directly from the bus driver.
- **Day Passes:** Ideal for unlimited travel within a day, perfect for sightseeing.
- **Travel Passes:** Offers unlimited travel over a set period (weekly or monthly), great for frequent commuters or students staying longer. [LIEmobil](#)



Payment Methods:

- Tickets can be paid for in Swiss francs or euros.
- Accepted payment methods include cash, credit cards, or REKA cards.

For cross-border travel to Austria and Switzerland, consider regional passes for discounted fares between the three countries.

Explore Liechtenstein by bike

Get on your bike!

If you enjoy exercising in nature, renting a bike is a great option in Liechtenstein. The **LIEbike** e-bike rental system allows you to easily rent a bike at stations across the country.

The E-Bike rental system:

- **LIEbike:** Rent an e-bike from 34 stations across Liechtenstein. Download the **LIEbike** app, register, and use the QR code on the bike to unlock it.
- **Pricing:** CHF 2 for the first 30 minutes, CHF 20 for a 24-hour pass, and CHF 100/year (first 30 minutes free per ride).




Geography

Location

The principality of Liechtenstein is one of the smallest countries in Europe. Despite its small size, Liechtenstein is an attractive location in the heart of Europe on the shore of the Rhine river between Switzerland and Austria. Its capital is Vaduz.



It takes only an hour by car to reach the city of Zurich and its international airport. The cities of Munich, Innsbruck and Milan are just a two-hour drive away. Excellent transport connections with the border countries make it easy to get to and from Liechtenstein to the cities in the region.

Road Safety for Cyclists

VCL Verkehrs-Club Liechtenstein

Association with nearly 400 members, part of the ATE (Association for Transport and Environment) Switzerland. Founded in 1980.

Shared Use Paths: Pedestrians/ Cyclists:

- Always ride your bicycle
- Ride the bicycle only in the permitted direction
- When crossing pedestrian areas, pedestrians have the right of way. You dismount your bicycle and walk across.

Cycling Along Roads:

- Speed Limit: Maximum 25 km/h
- Bicycles: Normal bicycles (including racing bicycles)
- Pedelects:
 - Slow Pedelects: Provide support up to 25 km/h. No helmet required.
 - Fast Pedelects: Provide support up to 45 km/h. A helmet is required.
- Ride in the correct direction:
 - Never cycle against the flow of traffic
 - Only use the bicycle lane if it's clearly marked as bi-directional

Cycling on Sidewalks:

Cycling is usually not allowed on sidewalks unless explicitly permitted.

- Pedestrians have the right of way.
- For fast pederlects: Switch off the motor when cycling on sidewalks.



To See and be Seen

Visibility in dimmed headlight of a car

- 25 m in dark clothing
- 40 m in bright clothing
- 100 m with good headlight
- 140 m with reflectors

Important: Always wear reflective material to increase your visibility

Best placement: on your legs and left arm, where movement is most visible to drivers




Left Turn

Left turns can be challenging for cyclists

Be aware of these key points:

- Stay in your lane
- Do not cut behind



1? Look behind

2? Signal with hand

3? Move into position

4? Ride clearly

5? Yield


6? Make a wide turn

7? Continue riding

Sorting Lanes

When there are multiple lanes:

- Ride in the center of the lane you are using



Public Transportation

Bus

University of Liechtenstein – Bus Stop

Fürst-Franz-Josef-Strasse 38, Vaduz

The nearest bus stop to the University of Liechtenstein is **Vaduz, Ebenholz/Universität**.

In addition, the **Vaduz local bus (Ortsbus)** runs free of charge and stops at **Spörrey**, which is only a short walk from the campus.



Train

There are good train connections to and from Liechtenstein. The main train stations in the surrounding region are **Feldkirch (Austria)** as well as **Sevelen, Buchs SG, and Sargans (Switzerland)**.

All train stations can be reached by bus from Liechtenstein within a few minutes.

- **Sevelen Bahnhof:** 9475 Sevelen, Switzerland

Places of interest

Liechtenstein lies in the shore of the Rhine river. Around half of its surface area lies in the mountains (Central Alps). The country has different attractive natural landscapes near the river and in the Alps region. Castles, lakes, trekking routes, and ski resorts are some of the attractions of the country

Top 4 places to visit:

1. **Malbun & Gaflei:** Malbun, 9497 Triesenberg
A popular spot for hiking and skiing in the Alps. Stunning mountain views make it a must for nature lovers.
2. **Badesee Grossabünd:** 9487 Gamprin
A natural swimming lake perfect for relaxing, swimming or enjoying a sunny afternoon with friends.
3. **Vaduz Castle:** Bergstrasse 2, 9490 Vaduz
The landmark of Liechtenstein and residence of the princely family. A great place to learn about the country's history.
4. **Rhine and Sandbanks**
Beautiful walking and biking trails along the Rhine River, with sandbanks to relax by the water.



Areas to chill

Besides bars and people's homes, you also have opportunities to go to alternative places to hang out. The following places make the country special, as they define the character of the place and the time you spend with your friends.

Grilling Spot - Located at Rüfestrasse/ Fürst-Johannes-Strasse

Close to the university, after a 5-minute walk up the hill (Rüfestrasse) you find an amazing bbq area which is very popular among students. This is the place where fun nights start. Besides several grilling spots and the wood provided, you also find bathrooms and a small football-pitch. The classical spot for birthday parties or farewells.

Rhine Valley area

You might have noticed already, the Rhine-river is the natural border between Liechtenstein and Switzerland. Plenty of reasons exists for going there: Jogging, cycling, hanging out are just a few. The view is stunning and the vibe is relaxing.



Badesee Grossabünt - Gamprin

Should you catch warm days after your arrival here, seize the opportunity and go to Badesee Grossabünt in Gamprin! There you will find a beautifully maintained lake with a grass shore to chill and more. A football pitch, beach volleyball area and furth



Walensee

In a 30 min car drive you can reach the Walensee, a big lake in Switzerland. You can go there for swimming, beach volleyball, sup, windsurfing, ...



Malbun, Steg, Sücka, Gaflei, Triesenberg, Planken

All those villages are located on the mountain in Liechtenstein. You can enjoy a scenic view over the rhine valley from there. Everywhere you will find walking paths and benches to rest.

In winter you can go skiing in Malbun or sledging from Sücka.



Hinterwasser, Balzers

A place at the Rhine in Balzers at the border to Switzerland. The highway is a little bit more far from this place, that is why it is more quiet. Perfect place to hang out, go for a swim or having a BBQ.



St. Mameta, Triesen

A little chapel in Triesen. It is located in the "green lounge" of the village and you have a beautiful view over the valley.



Hiking

Alpspitz

The most famous mountain in Liechtenstein. You start in Gaflei and use the Fürstensteig to reach the peak. ↻ n your way down you can use another track. With a break you need between 2-3 hours.



Grauspitz

The Graupitz is the highest mountain in Liechtenstein. A demanding hike.



Saxer Lücke

A scenic hike in Switzerland.



Drei Schwestern

A demanding hike. You should plan it as a daytrip.



Shopping

Feldkirch, Bludenz, Dornbirn, Innsbruck

The closest stores in Austria are in Feldkirch. You can find a bigger choice in Dornbirn (Messepark). Also in Bludenz (Zimbapark/Lünerseepark) you find some stores. The next big city is Innsbruck.



Buchs

Buchs is the closest option. The small town has some stores.



Chur

You can find a bigger choice in Chur. Chur is easy to reach by train or car.



Landquart Fashion Outlet

The outlet offers 160 different brands and is a 20min car drive from Vaduz.
